PRE-COLLEGE PORTFOLIO DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

Free to students with high school instructor's note of recommendation

This course offers tools and techniques for creating a successful visual art portfolio. Students will continue to develop their individual style through a variety of assignments. Experimentation is strongly encouraged. This class includes demonstrations and hands-on practice and seeks to refine techniques and presentation skills. Each student will be given personalized direction in the selection of an area of concentration in the building of a portfolio and receive recommendations on development of additional portfolio quality works of art. Seating is extremely limited for this class. Students will be enrolled on a first – come, first – served basis.

PRE-COLLEGE ART STUDIO PROGRAM

July 16 – July 20
8 AM – 5 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

Spend a week immersed in the college experience. This intensive one-week program is designed to help prepare rising junior and senior high school students for college admission in the fields of art and design. Students create portfolio building work through figure drawing classes, concentrated electives and open studio times. To be accepted to this program, the student must include a letter of recommendation from an instructor with the registration form.

All students will spend half of their day in a figure drawing class. Understanding the human figure is a fundamental skill for visual artists. Students will focus on drawing from live models (both male and female nudes). Through careful observation and innovative drawing techniques, students will tackle complex figurative forms. Students will begin to develop expressive mark-making and strengthen drawing skills in this intensive class.

Half of the day will be spent in an elective of the students' choice, including animation, graphic design, illustration, interior design, painting or photography. The program concludes with exhibition of student work and reception for family & friends.
