The early estimates of your eligibility for financial aid provided by the net calculator apply to full-time, first-time degree seeking students only. The estimated costs are based on full-time enrollment in the Associate of Fine Arts Degree Program. The room and board estimates are based on a shared room. These estimates do not represent a final determination, or actual award, of financial assistance or a final net price; they are only estimates based on price of attendance and financial aid provided to students in 2009-2010. Price of attendance and financial aid availability change from year to year. The results provided by the calculator are dependent upon the accuracy and completeness of the information entered and are intended to provide only a general guide of your potential eligibility for financial aid. These estimates shall not be binding on the Secretary of Education, this institution of higher education and the State in which this institution of higher education is located.

This does not replace the financial aid application requirements which include completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> in order to determine eligibility for Federal financial aid that includes Federal grant, loan, or work-study assistance. Not all students receive financial aid.

Once you have applied to the College contact the DCAD Financial Aid Office to complete the financial aid process. This will allow you to explain personal financial information that can't be addressed by FAFSA and will provide you with an accurate cost and available aid based on your personal situation. Remember some financial aid programs are limited and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Don't miss out, apply early.

1. This is not an application for admission or financial aid.
2. The results will only be as reliable as the data you provide.
3. The net price calculator will only give you an estimate of your net price and aid eligibility. The DCAD Financial Aid Office has the final word on your financial aid award.
