



Call for Submissions: DCAD@20 ART EXHIBITION AND SALE

Delaware College of Art and Design is pleased to announce an open call to all DCAD alumni, faculty, staff and current students for traditional and non-traditional visual art that will be exhibited and sold to help fund DCAD scholarships. The "DCAD@20 Exhibition" will feature works that reflect the breadth and depth of the talent and creativity within the DCAD community. All works will be shown in a six-week curated exhibition that will culminate in the charity gala to celebrate DCAD's 20th anniversary.

- **There is no fee to submit artwork for the exhibition.**
- **Registration for inclusion in the exhibition must be completed at www.dcad.edu**

ELIGIBILITY: All media is acceptable. Art must be available for sale in order to be included in the exhibition*. There is no size restriction on 2-D artwork. 3-D pieces requiring a pedestal can be no larger than 24 x 24 x 24 in. There is no restriction on the footprint of freestanding sculptures.

PRESENTATION: All works must be ready for hanging. No claw or saw tooth hangers are permitted.

SELECTION: There is no restriction on the number of pieces that participants may submit. Incomplete registrations will not be accepted. *Please note: Because the gallery is open to the general public and viewable by passers-by of all ages, we cannot include works that feature sexual, violent or other adult-themed content.*

DEADLINE: Registration must be completed via the DCAD website via the link at www.dcad.edu. All work must arrive at DCAD no later than Friday, June 2, 2017.

SALES: All works in the exhibition are for sale. DCAD's Gala Committee will determine the sale price. DCAD will receive a gallery commission of 50%; the artist will receive 50%.

RECEIVING: Work must be delivered to DCAD between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., May 9 – June 2nd, or by arrangement with DCAD. All work must hang for the duration of the exhibition. **Artists are responsible for shipping and insurance costs to DCAD.** Please use correct packing procedures. Any unsold artwork will be donated to DCAD for future sales.

LIABILITY: Utmost care will be taken with all work. Artwork in the gallery is insured through DCAD, but artists are responsible for insurance while the work is in transit.

- Tuesday, May 9, 2017 – Friday, June 2, 2017: Deadline for receipt of entries at DCAD's mailing address (600 North Market Street Wilmington, DE 19801), with all 2-dimensional artwork ready to be hung
- Friday, September 8: "DCAD@20 Exhibition" Opening Reception
- Saturday, October 7: DCAD@20 Gala and Art Sale
