

Direct Transfer Agreement Delaware College of Art and Design and Pratt Institute

Delaware College of Art and Design and Pratt Institute agree to a Direct Transfer Agreement in which students who have or will have completed their A.F.A degree at DCAD may apply for transfer into the B.F.A. degree. This agreement covers the following majors: Fine Arts, Communications Design, Photography, Animation (2-D) and Interior Design. Students are required to complete the admissions application as a transfer applicant, and to submit a portfolio and DCAD transcript and transcripts for any other college attended. (Please see attached equivalency tables for details.)

Admission to Pratt is contingent on a successful portfolio review by the academic department to which the student wishes to transfer. Transfer credit will be granted on the basis of the criteria specified below.

Policy on Acceptance of Transfer Credits

As noted above, DCAD students who will be admitted to Pratt must have a strong portfolio of work that has been judged to meet departmental standards.

In addition, they must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and have passed all course work. Only courses identified on the attached equivalency tables, in which students have earned grades of C or better, will transfer for credit.


Additional understandings:

- For DCAD students wishing to pursue a major at Pratt other than the major they completed at DCAD, transcripts will be evaluated on a course by course basis
- DCAD students wishing to change their major to Fashion or Architecture will start at Pratt as freshmen

Common Obligations

Representatives from each campus will confer to review and/or modify this agreement as a result of curricular changes at either institution. Each institution will put forth best efforts to publicize this agreement. DCAD will publicize this agreement both on their web site and in their annual catalog.
