Studio Lighting (PH227, 3 credits) *Traditional, Commercial and Photojournalism Track*

Course Description:

Studio Lighting is a lecture-demonstration course for the serious photographer who has a firm grasp of basic black-and-white photographic skills. This course includes the use of tungsten and electronic flash illumination for portraiture, still life, and interior photography.

Prerequisite: Photography II or Commercial Photography: Black and White or Photojournalism: Black and White

Students will:

1. Create a proper (desired) exposure using a variety of lighting sources. (PC 1)
2. Demonstrate ability to use mixed light sources. (PC 1)
3. Emulate images from the industry. (PC 1)
