POSITION DETAILS

Delaware College of Art & Design (DCAD) is accepting applications for the position of adjunct faculty to teach one section of introductory printmaking for the 2019 Spring semester.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

1. BFA degree in printmaking (MFA highly preferred).
2. Experience working in non-toxic relief and intaglio print process (non-etching).
3. Minimum of 1 year of collegiate teaching experience.
4. Awareness of studio maintenance and studio health and safety practice.

ADJUNCT FACULTY RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

1. Teach a course load of least one and no more than three courses per semester.
2. Support Fine Arts Area Coordinator in the upkeep and maintenance of the print studio.
3. Evaluate student work, post student progress, and provide grades in the manner and time prescribed.
4. Participate in the planning and implementation of Student Learning Outcomes Assessment (SLOA).
5. Participate, as appropriate, in events important to the life of the institution and its students, including faculty meetings, college-wide committees, guest artist lectures, and exhibition openings.
6. Adhere to College policies and procedures in addition to holding assigned class meetings and weekly office hours.
