

2 + 2 Agreement Moore College of Art & Design and Delaware College of Art and Design

Moore College of Art & Design (MOORE) welcomes eligible applicants to the 2 + 2 Program in order to facilitate the successful transfer of students from Delaware College of Art and Design (DCAD). Eligible students will enter MOORE with third-year (junior level) status for the purpose of enrolling in a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree program in one of the following areas/majors:

Animation & Game Arts
Fine Arts
Illustration
Graphic Design
Photography (+ Digital Arts)
Interior Design

Terms of 2 + 2 Agreement

This agreement shall remain in effect for a period of three years from the authorized signed date listed below, with the provision that the terms specified herein will continue to apply to students admitted from the Delaware College of Art and Design programs within one year of the expiration of the agreement. This agreement will commence for students planning to enroll at MOORE for fall 2019, 2020, and 2021.

Each institution agrees to provide timely notice to the other in the event of any modification to the curriculum that might affect the compatibility for admission and transfer of coursework. The current agreement will be reviewed and reassessed annually to insure curricular alignment. Students admitted to Delaware College of Art and Design's programs prior to such notification, and who have remained on schedule to complete their Delaware College of Art and Design studies on time, shall be admitted to Moore College of Art & Design on the basis of this agreement.

Provisions will be made to allow students who are already accepted to or enrolled at Moore College of Art & Design through the effective date of termination to receive the benefits articulated in the original terms of this agreement.

Student Requirements

To be eligible for the 2 + 2 Program between MOORE and DCAD, students must:

- Indicate an interest in applying to Moore College of Art & Design at the completion of one year at Delaware College of Art and Design.
- Submit a 2 + 2 intent form at the end of the first year

- Complete a MOORE admissions application by December 10 of the second and final year at DCAD.
- Graduate from DCAD with an AFA Degree, and achieve a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5, with no single grade below a C in articulated courses.
- Present a final official DCAD transcript
- Enroll at MOORE in the fall semester immediately following completion of their AFA Degree at DCAD (Note: in unusual circumstances, deferral for up to one year may be considered.)
- Complete at least 50% of BFA credits at Moore.
- Students who have previously matriculated at MOORE will not be eligible for participation in this program/agreement.

In order to secure the successful launch of this agreement, the participating colleges will do the following:

Moore College of Art & Design

- Provide information on the 2 + 2 program
- Waive the application fee
- Waive portfolio requirement
- Accept all DCAD articulated courses
- Provide a scholarship grid based on student applicant GPA
- Organize and host DCAD student and faculty trips to Moore with collaborating departments/majors
- Provide preferred/prioritized scheduling of advising and course enrollment

Delaware College of Art and Design

- Provide information on the 2 + 2 program
- Advertise 2 + 2 Agreement and Program on the DCAD website and other venues on campus
- Organize and host opportunities for Moore Admissions staff to visit DCAD, make classroom/studio presentations, and meet with interested and eligible students
- Collaborate with Moore Admissions staff on all details and successful execution of the agreement

Financial Aid

2 + 2 students will be awarded financial aid on the same basis as all Moore students and will have equal access to all state and federal financial aid programs for US citizens.


